| | Tap: Gently tap the specified area on the screen once with your fingertip. |
|---|---|
| | Scroll: Place your fingertip on the screen and slide your finger vertically. |
| | Long press (hold down): Hold your finger down on the specified area of the screen for about a second and release. |
| 5 | Swipe: Place your fingertip on the screen and slide your finger horizontally. |
