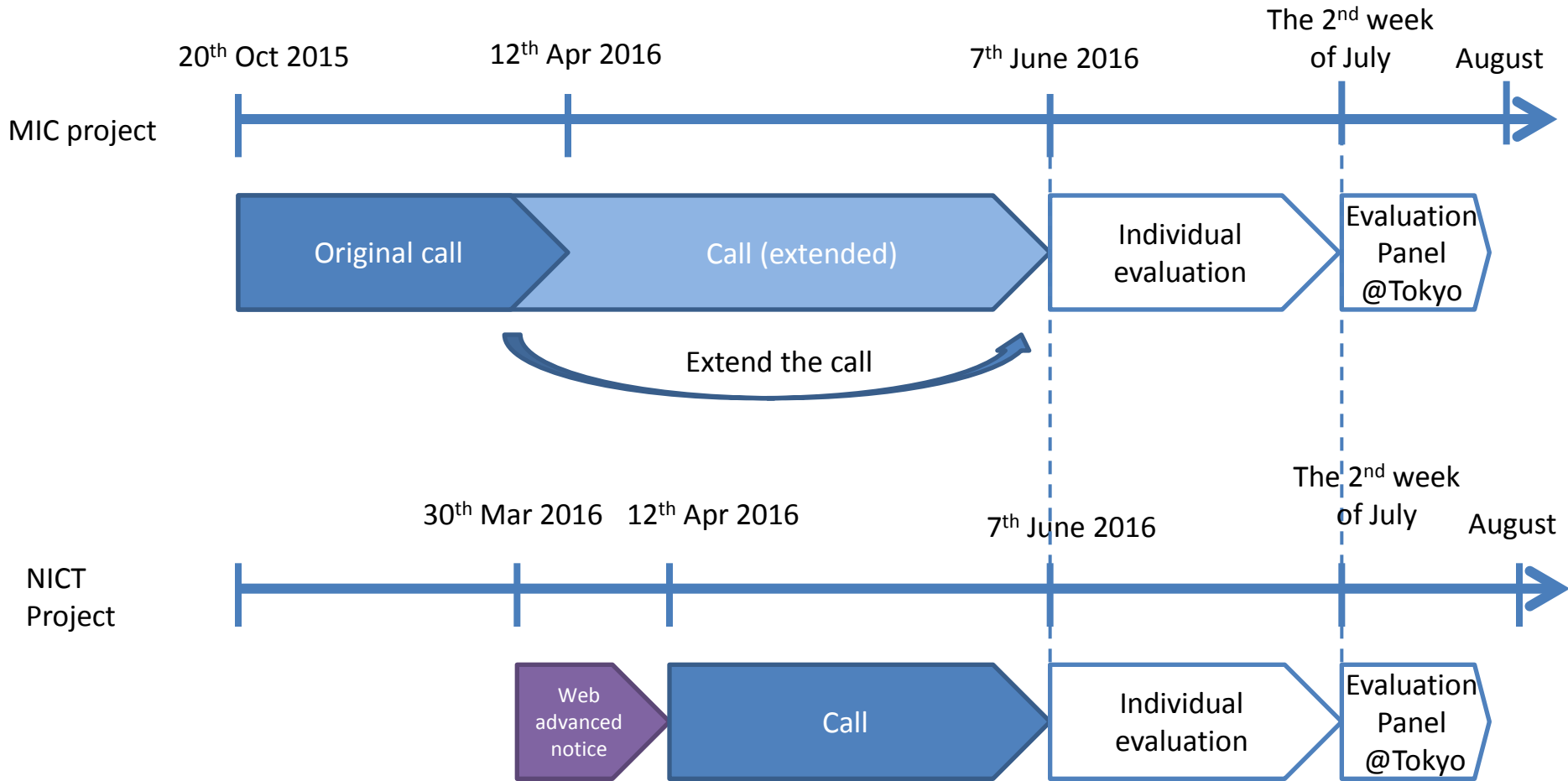

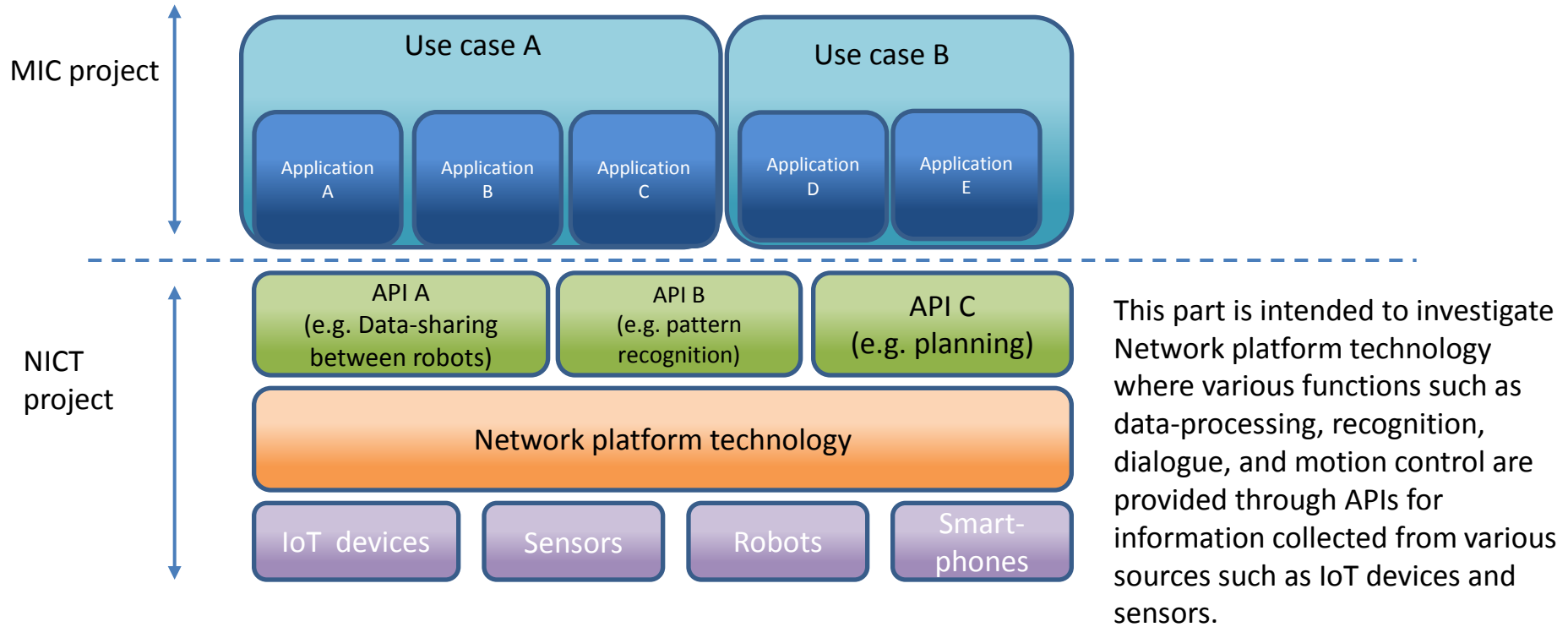

SC1-PM-14-2016 Schedule



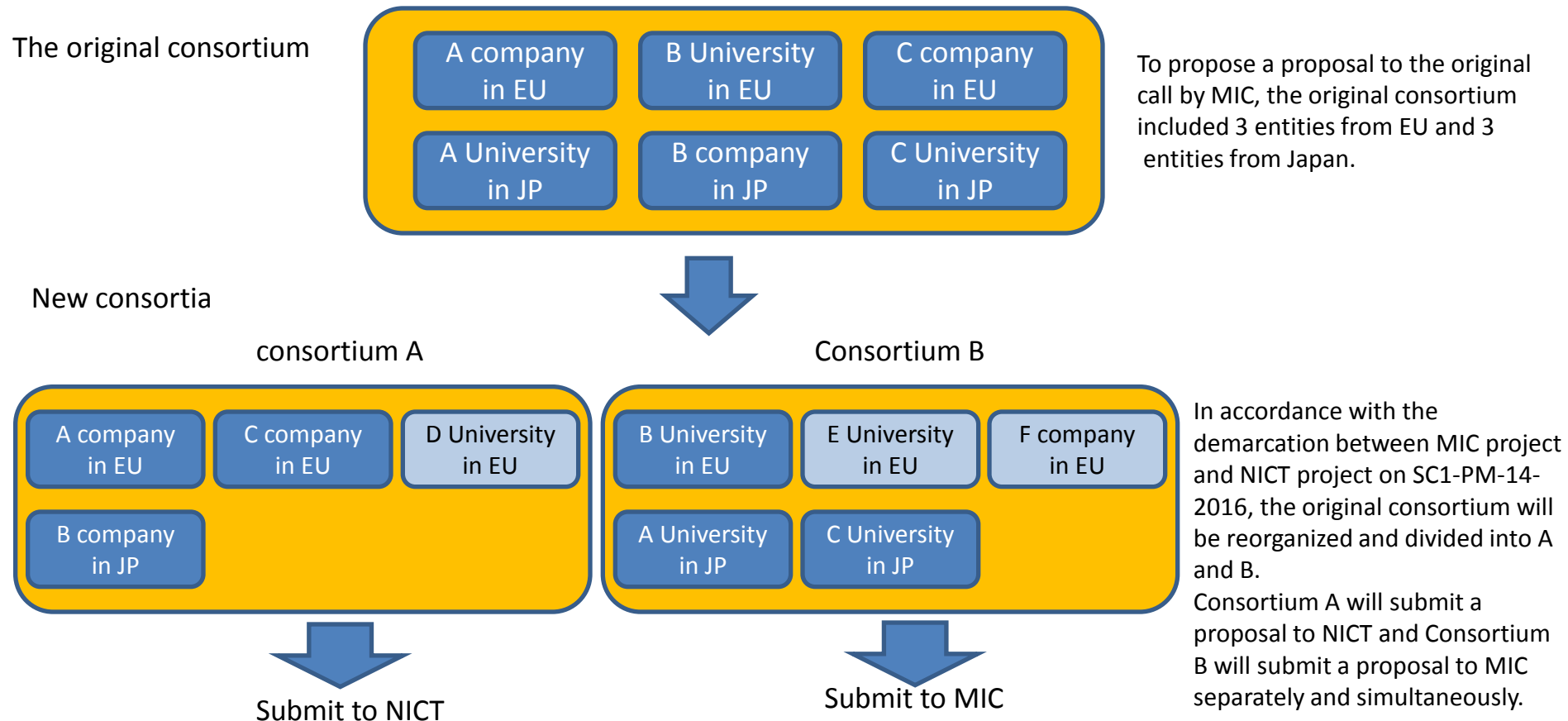
Demarcation between MIC project and NICT project on SC1-PM-14-2016



Note: If same proposals are submitted to both MIC and NICT by the applicant, MIC and NICT will reject them.

Change of the formation to submit a proposal related to SC1-PM-14-2016

For a consortium which is already submitted a proposal to MIC, it is possible to change the plan to submit a proposal to NICT only. In this case, the original proposal to MIC must be withdrawn. As another option, one consortium can be divided into 2 consortia and consortium A will submit a proposal to NICT and consortium B will submit a proposal to MIC.



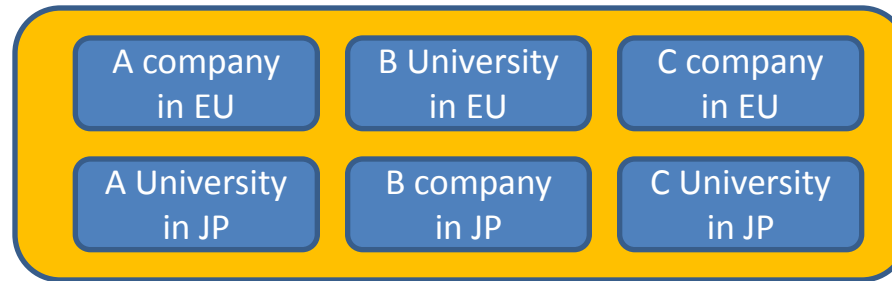
Note: To meet the condition that at least 3 countries in EU must be involved into each consortium, the consortium A which will submit a propose to NICT must have participants from 3 countries in EU.

Change of the formation to submit a proposal related to SC1-PM-14-2016

In case where the original consortium is divided into consortium A and consortium B, some or all universities and companies can be included into both consortia **on condition that**;

- no overlap in research between consortium A and B
- no researcher who has over 100% efforts
- A proposal submitted to NICT does not include any research related to MIC.
- A proposal submitted to MIC does not include any research related to NICT.

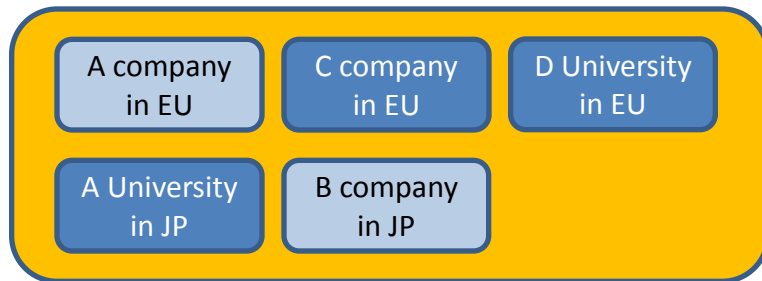
The original consortium



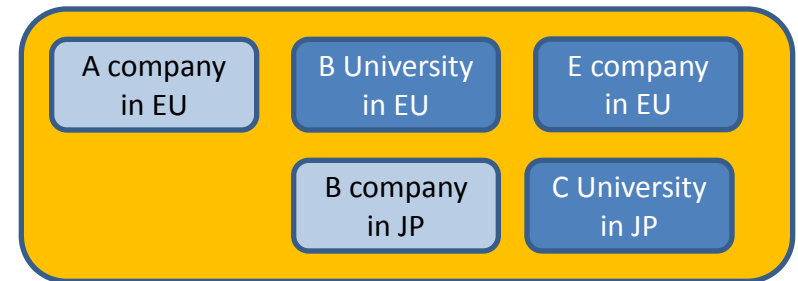
To propose a proposal to the original call by MIC, the original consortium included 3 entities from EU and 3 entities from Japan.

Submit to NICT

Although A company in EU and B company in JP are included into both consortia, It is possible for consortium A to submit a proposal to NICT if there is no overlap in research between consortium A and B, no exceed 100% efforts of a researcher, and the proposal fulfills the demarcation between MIC project and NICT project on SC1-PM-14-2016.

Note: To meet the condition that at least 3 countries in EU must be involved into each consortium, the consortium A which will submit a propose to NICT must have participants from 3 countries in EU.
